You are first, last and always with us: help us to be always with you in our love for others. Amen.

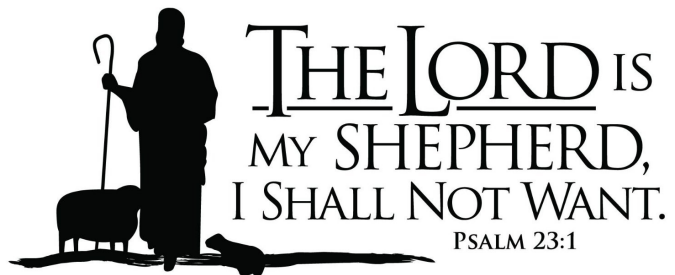
